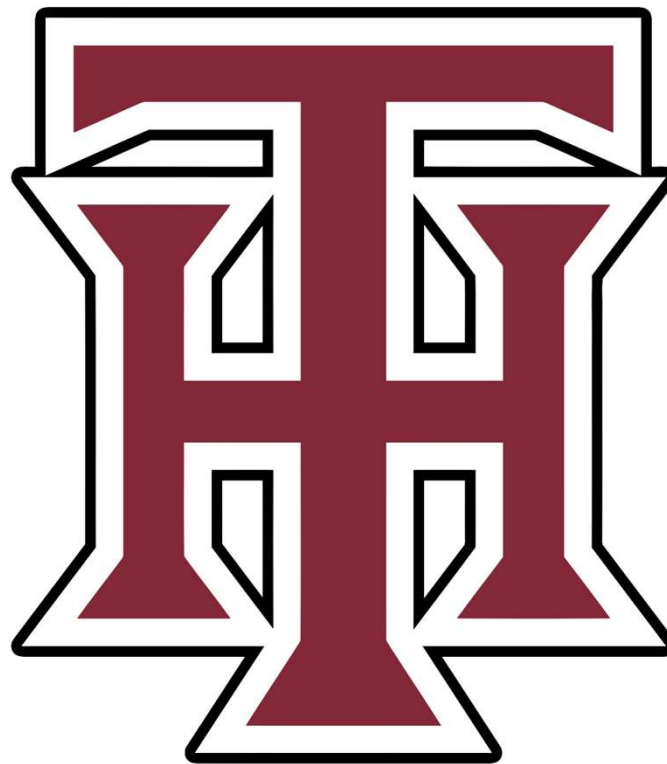

Course Selection Process

- ▶ March 18 - 20th: Grade level presentations in the theatre/Course Awareness Tour
- ▶ March 25th & 26th : Students fill out paper copies of course selection in HR
- ▶ March 27th & 28th: Students log in to their own Power School to input their course selections during Homeroom.
- ▶ April: Homeroom schedule to give out verification sheets for parental signature. Signed verification sheets to be returned to Homeroom teacher.

- ▶ Make your choices wisely as these cannot be easily changed.



Graduation Requirements (2026 and 2027)

Graduates must:

- have met learning requirements prescribed in Grade 9 curriculum
- have completed compulsory credit-hours in Grades 10 through 12
- have accumulated 100 credit-hours to apply for graduation
- have developed a documented career-life plan
- achieve a successful rating on the English Language Proficiency Assessment

Graduates must also accumulate:

- 80 total credit hours from the list of compulsory courses
- A minimum of 20 additional credit hours which may include elective courses.

Students can use up to 8 credit-hours from Challenge for Credit Courses, 4 credit-hours for Independent Study, and/or 8 credit-hours for Locally Developed Courses

You must have a minimum of 100 credit hours (25 courses) to graduate



Graduation requirement: Humanities Cluster

- ▶ Civics
OR
- ▶ FI Civics





Graduation requirement: Mathematics

- ▶ Geometry, Measurement and Finance 10

OR

- ▶ FI Geo Meas & Fin 10

AND

- ▶ Financial and Workplace Mathematics 110

OR

- ▶ Number, Relations and Functions 10 (FI)

**** If you are completing Geo 10 independently, you should choose NRF 10 and Foundations 110**





Graduation requirement: Mathematics

- ▶ If you are a student who is inclined to do trades or wants to directly enter the workplace, you should do:
 - ▶ Financial and Workplace Mathematics 11
- ▶ If you are a student who is inclined to go to university and does well in math:
 - ▶ Numbers Relations and Functions 10

Choose one of the following:

- ▶ Dramatic Arts 110
- ▶ Music 10
- ▶ Visual Arts 10

Certificates: French Immersion



- ▶ 50% of the course load in grade 9 must be FI designated (e.g. FI Science)
- ▶ A minimum of 10 courses or 40 credit hours with an FI designation in grades 10, 11 and 12 must be taken (e.g., FI Modern History 112)
