# Language A: HL Literature

The IB HL Literature course offers an in-depth exploration of diverse literary works, fostering critical analysis, appreciation of cultural contexts, and development of sophisticated written and oral communication skills.

## **HL Literature Course Requirements**

### • 3 semesters

- **Literary Works**: Study of 10 literary works (4 from Prescribed Reading List, 3 in translation) from a representative selection of literary forms (4), periods (3), and places (3 countries in 2 continents)
- Individual Oral: Analytical presentation (15 minutes) of a global issue of concern in two works studied (one in translation)
- HL Essay: A 1200-1500 word essay on one of the works studied
- Paper 1 Exam: A guided literary analysis to two previously unseen texts
- **Paper 2 Exam**: Comparative response to a question based on two works studied

Which one should I take?

### Should I take AA Math HL?

- Students who enjoy STEM courses.
- Requires strong conceptual understanding of math.
- Requires strong problem-solving skills.
- HL version is recommended for students going into the field of engineering.

### Should I take AI Math SL?

- Requires practical, real-world understanding of math.
- Focus is on applications and interpretation rather than abstract concepts.
- Suitable for students who need a solid foundation in mathematics but are not pursuing further studies in mathematical fields.
