

## Required and Recommended Course Pre-Requisites

- ► It is important to be aware of pre-requisites prior to making choices
  - ▶ For example:
    - ►English 10 requires a pass in English 9
    - ▶ Pre-Calculus 110 requires a pass in Foundations of Math 110.
- ► Other courses will come with a recommendation from their department this represents our best advice for the skills required to see success in these courses.
  - ▶ For example:
    - ▶ Physics 11 should be taken after Number Relations and Functions 10.
